## DEATH ON BIRTHDAY

NORWICH L.N.E.R. OFFICIAL  
KILLED BY TRAIN

TRAGEDY AT COUNTY  
SCHOOL

Chief Permanent Way Inspector J. Lunness, of Norwich, was run down and killed by the 11.49 train from Dereham to Norwich, via Wroxham, near County School Station yesterday.

Apparently he was walking along the permanent way on his usual inspection duties, accompanied by Telegraph-Inspector Robinson, also of Norwich. Robinson managed to jump clear of the train, but Lunness was killed instantly.

The body was removed to County School Station, where an inquest was being held this afternoon.

Mr. Lunness was a married man, aged about 63, and we understand that yesterday was his birthday.
